The work session commenced at 6:00 with a presentation from Butch Gabrialski and Rick Thune. Mr. Gabrialski presented two land options for consideration. The first is a piece of property off Highway 86, south on County Road 17. It is a treed 3-1/2 acre site currently outside of the town limits. There is electricity, a well and septic, but town water & sewer would need to be connected to the property as well as a high speed internet connection.

The second option was a parcel in the Gold Creek Commons development north of Highway 86 on the far west edge of Elizabeth town limits. This property has been annexed into Elizabeth, but there are currently no services on the property. The 2 acre site is adjacent to the proposed recreation center.

Elizabeth Town Administrator, Chris LaMay, answered questions and participated in further discussion about various properties in and around the Elizabeth area.
